

PLAYING TIPS AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR **SENSORY HANDPAN**

- Do not play the instrument with brute force. If you are unsure how to produce the best sounds, talk to a professional handpan teacher to learn the proper technique.
- 2. Play the handpan only with your fingers and not with mallets or drumsticks. Also, take off any metal jewelry that could cause dents or scratches on the instrument.
- 3. Avoid banging the handpan on hard objects or dropping it. This could cause the instrument to become out of tune.
- 4. Do not place the handpan upside down on the sound fields.
- 5. Transport the handpan only in a secure handpan case. Include dehumidifier pads or bags when traveling for long periods.
- 6. Please store the handpan in a dry place, and avoid long exposure of the instrument to moisture (e.g. water, rain, high humidity, sweat). Important: Permanent storage in a closed bag is not recommended. It is possible that condensing moisture is contained in the bag, as textiles and plastics can store it.
- 7. Wipe the handpan with a dry cotton cloth after playing to remove any possible moisture right away.
- To prevent oxidation and contamination, clean the handpan from time to time with our Meinl Sonic Energy Stainless Steel Handpan Care Set (SSHPCS). This contains a cleaner for pre-cleaning and a protectant to seal the surface.
